### Teeth on Wheels

Teeth On Wheels will be visiting our school for dental check-ups starting on June 30th 2025 if you would like to make an appointment for your child/ren.

Early dental visits are crucial for your child's long-term oral health. At this visit, Teeth On Wheels will help identify and address common dental concerns. To ensure your child is part of this visit, please complete the consent form by clicking the link below:

Once completed, the Teeth On Wheels team will Check your child's eligibility for FREE care under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS). If your child is not eligible, Teeth On Wheels is offering a special deal of \$125 for a full check-up, clean, fluoride treatment, and any required x-rays (which can be claimed through your private health insurance).

Important: The cut-off date for completing your child's form is June 24th 2025.


